

**THE HAWAIIAN STEEL GUITAR ASSOCIATION
SCHOLARSHIP AGREEMENT**

CONGRATULATIONS! The Hawaiian Steel Guitar Association Scholarship Committee has approved your child's application for a (**circle one:** 1st, 2nd, or 3rd) Scholarship to receive Hawaiian Steel Guitar Lessons from the following School or Studio:

The Scholarship is valued at \$550 for Ten Lessons. Scholarship Funds are paid directly to the School or Studio. The start date for the lessons is to be determined by the studio/teacher, in consultation with you and/or the student. Generally, lessons are once per week and may be provided in-person or over the internet (Skype or Zoom Call).

Upon completion of the first eight lessons, you may apply for an additional scholarship, if your child has made satisfactory progress and still meets the age limitation (age 17 or younger) at the time of the new application. The maximum number of scholarships is three (30 lessons)

By accepting this scholarship and any subsequent scholarships, the student and parent(s) agree to comply with the following terms and conditions:

1. Student agrees to dedicate study and practice time in between lessons, as directed by the teacher/instructor.
2. Student and Parent(s) agree to submit a video recording of the Student playing Hawaiian Steel Guitar demonstrating progress to the HSGA Scholarship Committee at the end of the Ten Lesson Course.
3. **Student and Parent(s) agree to allow The Hawaiian Steel Guitar Association to post videos on the internet with public access, for the purpose of promoting the HSGA organization and its mission of promoting the Hawaiian Music and the Hawaiian Steel Guitar.**
4. Student and Parent(s) agree to provide at least one public performance at the end of each Ten Lesson Course. Examples of performance venues include:
School talent shows, concerts or programs; Senior Centers or Care Facilities;
Community Concerts, Fairs, or Festivals; Church or Faith-Based gatherings or events; or other appropriate venues. Performances at Family Parties and Gatherings, Restaurants, Nightclubs may also be accepted. A video recording of the public performance may satisfy the required "Progress" video recording. (#2)
